“We have delivered stronger financial results for our second quarter according to plan and we expect to have strong revenues for the balance of our fiscal year based on current sales backlog”, said Martin Hauschild, President and CEO of Seprotech. “At the end of Q1 we reported that a major R&D focus would be on the full-scale integration of membranes into our wastewater treatment technology. I am happy to report that the engineering development for a full-scale project is complete. Our goal is to be able to recycle wastewater to potable water quality and to do so at a very reasonable cost. We will make a technical announcement in the current fiscal year once the necessary intellectual property filings are complete.

Management anticipates continued strength in the resources sector where Seprotech supplies equipment to the mining and oil and gas industries. The United States land development market remains weak due to the downturn in the housing industry, however, developers appear to showing interest in new development projects two years out which is a marked improvement over this time last year. Sales and marketing efforts offshore are continuing and are aimed at offsetting weakness in the United States. Overall, management is satisfied with the overall positioning of the Company in the marketplace.

“Seprotech revenues at the end of the second quarter are now at the same level as they were for the whole of last year,” said Justin Connidis, Chairman of Seprotech, “The Company is having a good year and we look forward to continued growth as the importance of clean water and environmental consciousness become increasing priorities in governments and private industry. As an environmental technology company, Seprotech has the opportunity to play an important role in protecting water resources.”

Seprotech is a provider of pre-engineered water and wastewater treatment plants to the land development, resource sector and military market place, including membrane-based water treatment systems and the ROTORDISK® biological wastewater treatment systems.
